### Icy Strait Point

Beyond the active adventures—like watching the whales, hiking the trails, and flying one of the highest and longest ZipRiders—this is also a place for learning the traditions and cultures of the native Tlingit people.

### Juneau

With more hiking trails than roads—you can't even get here by road—Juneau welcomes you for a tram ride up the side of Mount Roberts, dog sledding on the huge Mendenhall Glacier, and whale watching in scenic Auke Bay.

### Ketchikan

Admire the many totem poles and explore the rich vein of indigenous culture in this quintessential Alaskan town. Fly over Misty Fjords National Monument and look down on thousand-foot waterfalls. Then catch a lumberjack show.

### Skagway

Return to the 1890s Klondike Gold Rush in this former boomtown, where prospectors launched their rugged treks deep into the Yukon goldfields. You can still ride the White Pass Railway here and pan for gold yourself.

# DISCOVER THE GLORY OF HUBBARD GLACIER.



Comprised of the longest river of ice in North America, beginning in Canada and flowing 76 miles to Russell Fjord, the glacier originates at Mount Logan, North America's second-tallest mountain. And while 95% of the world's glaciers are retreating, Hubbard Glacier is still advancing.

As the largest advancing tidewater glacier in North America, Hubbard Glacier's terminal face is the dramatic end of a process that began 450 years ago as snowfall on the slopes of Mount Logan. Where it meets the sea, the blue wall of ice rises 350 feet above the waterline and extends 250 feet below. Forward movement of up to 36 feet per day results in regular calving — breathtaking moments when ice cleaves off the wall in enormous pieces that can reach the size of five-story buildings. With calving occurring on a daily basis, Hubbard Glacier offers the best opportunity to observe glacial processes as they unfold — a true once-in-a-lifetime experience. Your captain will slowly turn the ship into Yakutat Bay, navigating the awe-inspiring sight of the wall of ice that stretches seven miles wide. Enjoy incredible picture-perfect views from just about anywhere as our dedicated onboard naturalist narrates the natural drama as it unfolds.

### Denali Flyer (Talkeetna)

Explore Denali, the tallest mountain in North America, and the surrounding range and wilderness on a flightseeing ride that takes you within six miles of the magnificent Kahiltna Glacier. Take in views only mountaineers and a select few get to see. Fly to the remote western end of Denali National Park and see Denali, Mt. Foraker, and Mt. Hunter, above the longest glacier in Denali National Park.



### Scenic Mountain Ascent and World's Largest ZipRider (Icy Strait Point)

Soar 300 feet above the treetops on a thrilling ZipRider Cable Car Adventure. Begin your journey with a relaxing scenic ride though the village of Hoonah, home to the indigenous Tlingit ]people, en route to the mountainside starting point of the world's longest single zipline.



### Husky Homestead (Denali)

Leave the crowds behind and join an intimate group to meet champion sled dogs at the Husky Homestead. Enjoy a personal tour of the homestead kennel of four-time Iditarod champion, Jeff King. Meet the champion canines, cuddle the puppies, and see the huskies' summertime training.

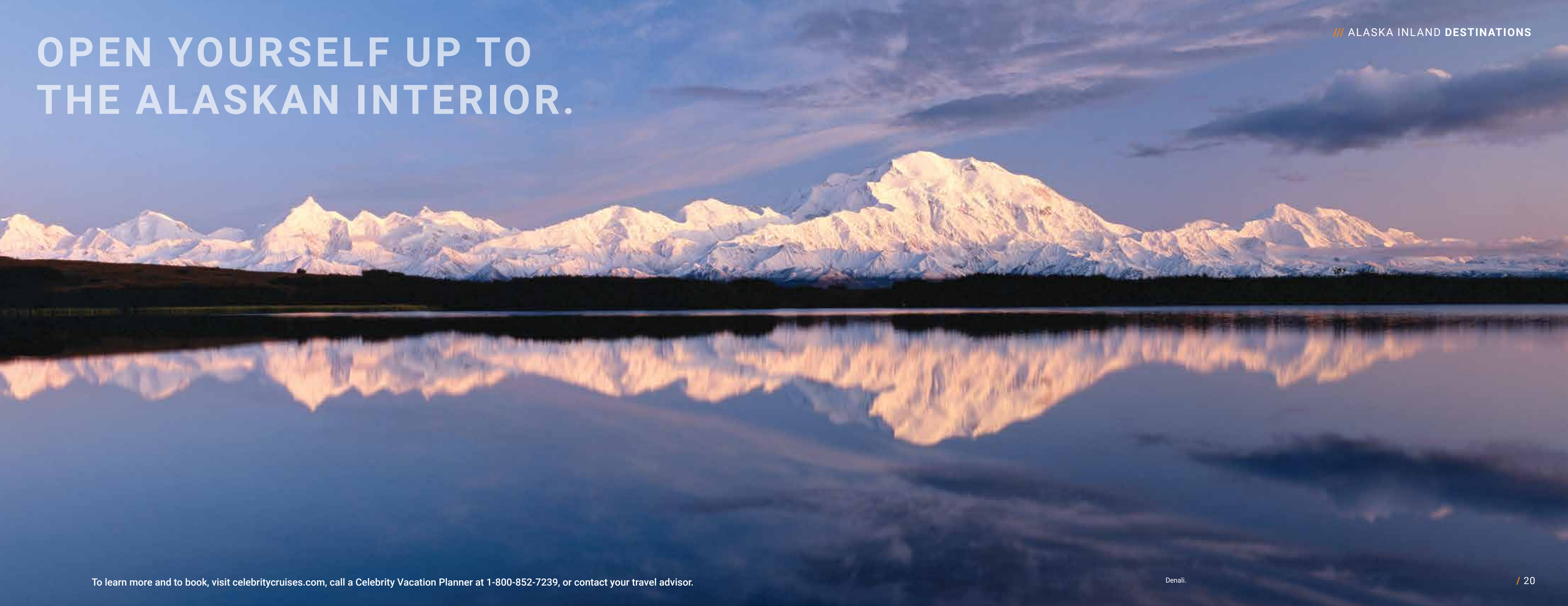

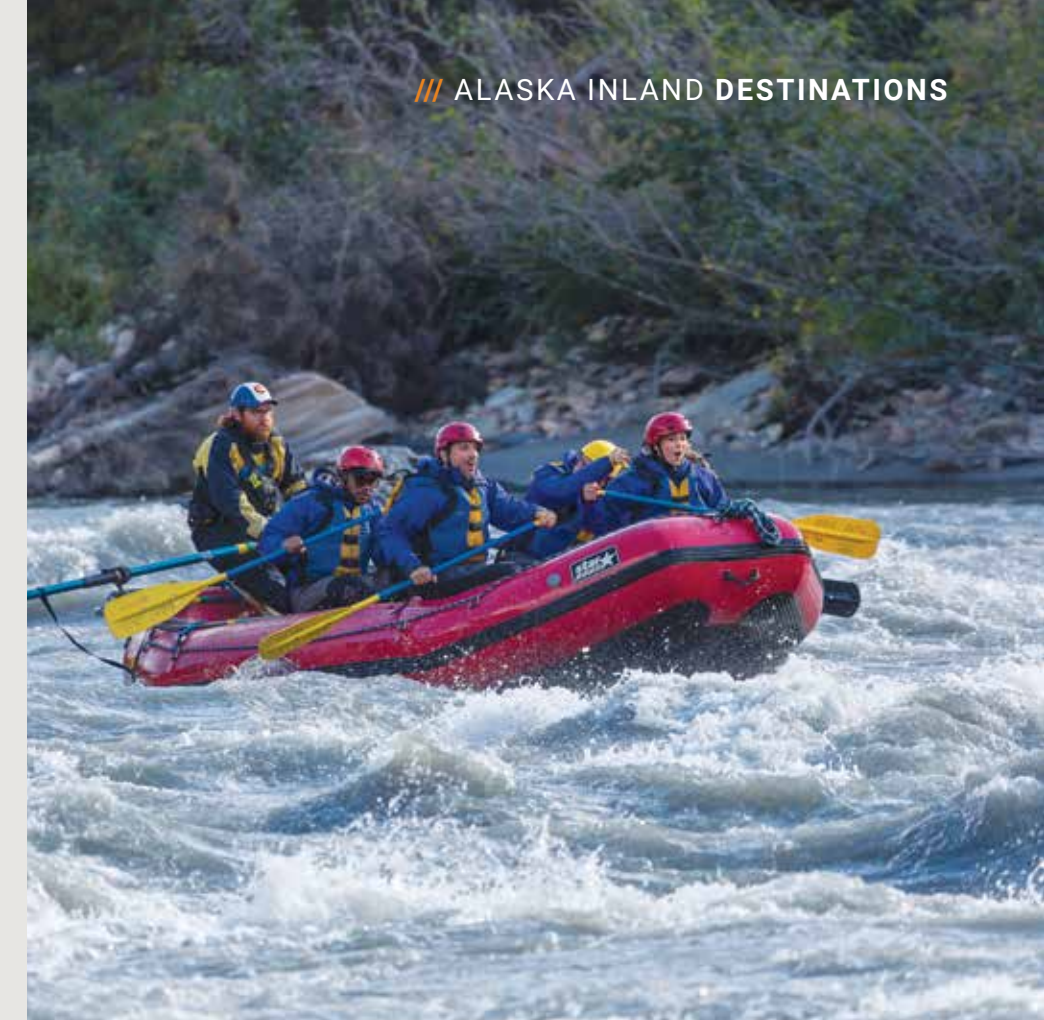
## I DENALI

Enter the vast expanse of subarctic wilderness known as Denali National Park, home to abundant wildlife and magnificent vistas — truly one of Earth’s last frontiers.

Denali National Park boasts six million acres of pristine wild land. The varied subarctic landscape is home to grizzly bears, moose, caribou, Dall sheep, and wolves, as well as endangered birds. Wild animals roam as they have for millennia through unspoiled backcountry of taiga forest, alpine tundra, and snow-capped peaks. The sheer expanse of wilderness, the solitude of the single road, and the park’s status as one of the last true, intact, subarctic ecosystems makes Denali one of the best places in the country to view wildlife in their natural habitat.

The Visitor Center offers fascinating natural history exhibits, films, and the opportunity to meet and speak to rangers about Denali National Park, including its centerpiece mountain, Denali. At 20,320 feet, Denali is North America’s highest peak, and is still growing. Rising miles into the sky, the mountain known as the Great One towers over the summits of the surrounding Alaska Range. The view on a clear day is a profoundly impressive sight.

The highly protected backcountry that makes up the majority of the park is cleaved only by a solitary road. It runs 92-miles into the wilderness and stretches through bottomland taiga-evergreen forests, into the higher elevations that offer open views of the tundra-covered slopes and river valleys, all framed by the indomitable Alaska Range. And while the backcountry’s pristine wilderness is protected, Denali’s front-country is open to a range of activities. Flightsightseeing planes soar over the mountains for breathtaking views, while rafting on the Nenana River can be a gentle float or a thrilling white-water ride. With the hinterland open to biking, off-roading, and hiking, Denali National Park offers both active adventures and time in unspoiled nature.







## FAIRBANKS

/// ALASKA INLAND DESTINATIONS



Alaska's most remote city is also its second largest, a gold-rush boomtown that today is a regional hub for culture and recreation.

Born of a turn-of-the-century trader who found himself stranded in what is present-day downtown, Fairbanks was founded when gold was discovered nearby and the trading post blossomed into a thriving city that outlasted its gold rush boom. Today, locals pride themselves on their independence and endurance, many being descended from Native Peoples and the gold rush prospectors whose self-sufficiency was the driving force of the town's conception.

Hugging the northern bank of the Chena River that converges with the unyielding Tanana, the Chena sternwheelers that navigate Fairbanks's waters afford

breathtaking views of the city and countryside, while also offering a glimpse into Alaska's rich interior traditions.

Exploring Fairbanks means participating in the day-to-day experiences that have contributed to Fairbanks referring to itself as 'extremely Alaska'. Pan for gold in one of the many creeks that still turn up flakes of gold, or admire the enduring native art treasures on display at the Museum of the North, whose shimmering contours reflect the mountain ranges that encircle it. With the locals playing late into the night, like the midnight sun baseball game held every solstice, your options to explore are as lengthy as the long summer nights.





## ANCHORAGE

A cosmopolitan city perched on the edge of the wilderness, Anchorage is a gateway to natural attractions and the state’s center for the preservation of Alaskan Native cultures.

Blending cosmopolitan excitement and the great outdoors, the city has a youthful exuberance that contributes to its lively nightlife, eclectic dining, and adventuresome atmosphere.

Beyond the city limits of “Alaska’s Big Apple,” nature commands the terrain. As many as 60 glaciers are located within an hour’s drive. Urbanites can go for an icy hike by day, and by night enjoy Anchorage under the late evening sun, socializing at a downtown brewery over a local craft beer. Even on weekdays it’s not uncommon to find a suited city worker angling for a catch on a lunch break.

Unlike any other American city, Anchorage boasts 250 miles of trails, sees moose passing through its neighborhoods, and is visited by whales that surface

in the waters alongside the Tony Knowles Coastal Trail. And long summers days mean more time to explore its natural beauty by day and sample its innovative frontier fare long into the evening.

Anchorage is home to Native Peoples from around the state, making the city the destination for discovering local history, art, and crafts at the heart of the Alaskan identity. The Anchorage Museum preserves an extensive collection of native art, spanning prehistoric times to the present day. And the Alaskan artifacts at the Smithsonian Arctic Studies Center were curated and interpreted with help from the Alaska Native Heritage Center, a renowned cultural center and an exciting place to connect with indigenous residents.

## SEWARD

On the shores of Resurrection Bay, this history-rich port town is nestled against the glacier-covered Kenai Mountains, and offers access to inspiring landscapes, incredible marine life, and exciting natural spectacles like calving glaciers.

The pristine wilderness of the Kenai Peninsula is home to nesting seabirds, countless islands, wetlands, and breathtaking coastal views. And, as the gateway to the Kenai Fjords National Park, the Harding Icefield — an expanse of ice and snow created over 23,000 years ago — is easily within reach and culminates in 40 glaciers that dramatically calve into the sea. The throngs of wildlife that course below, and glide above the glacial waters, are legion. Pods of humpback whales are known to breach when hunting, seals and sea lions lounge on rocky outcroppings and bald eagles hover overhead.

The rugged landscape suits Seward’s hardy locals well. Every July 4th, Seward’s runners race 1.5 miles up and down Mount Marathon.

Starting at sea level, the race rises 3,000 feet in elevation over very steep terrain. Runners race over gullies, ice, and snow, using their hands to haul themselves to the finish line. And, when not racing up mountains, you can find stalwart locals at city watering holes and dining spots, where you can savor fresh Alaskan seafood, filleted and flayed straight from the ocean to your plate.

Situated at a grand natural intersection where bays and fjords stretching south to the Pacific meet the crested wilderness — and connected to communities extending northwards via the famously scenic Seward Highway — Seward is emblematic of the wildly beautiful state that is Alaska.





Nestled in a glacier-carved valley surrounded by the grandeur of the Chugach Mountains, Alyeska offers stunning views at every turn.

Tucked in a luxuriant glacier-carved valley, encircled by the Chugach Mountains and bordering a temperate rainforest, Girdwood is a playground for the artists and extreme athletes who call her home. Meandering up Mt. Alyeska along the trails mottled with wildflowers to enjoy sensational views, is as pure a Girdwood experience as a helicopter ride to an alpine camp, where Alaskan sled dogs are waiting to be driven.

The luxurious Hotel Alyeska Resort is the allure of the area, offering a perfect blend of service and hospitality while keeping you connected to the beauty

of your surroundings. Journey to the top of the mountain on the Aerial Tram. From the 2,300-foot summit, the glistening view of the seven hanging glaciers is awe-inspiring. And, alongside enjoying the wild lands outdoors, indulge in the extravagant indoors, with both casual and elegant dining perched at the mountain top, or relax at the spa in its lush valley setting.

Situated on three rivers in sight of the great mountain, Talkeetna offers breathtaking views, a folksy frontier spirit, endless outdoor activities, and the unique ambience of its eclectic Main Street.

Among climbers, Talkeetna is recognized as the ideal staging ground for preparations to summit Denali. Mountaineers from around the world start here, filling the town's hotels and bars with expedition excitement. With a population of under 1,000, Talkeetna has a small but lively local community dedicated to keeping the backcountry spirit of Alaska alive. The log cabin cafés, along with the heritage buildings of its historic Main Street, provide a place where you can mill with the bohemians, aviators, and adventurers who call the town home.

The town's unique location offers breathtaking views of the tallest peak in North America and provides access to every imaginable way to experience the

magnificence of "The Great One" — from seasoned bush pilots taking you up into the skies and over the awe-inspiring north face, to leisurely hikes on quiet trails and river rafting down the glacier-fed Talkeetna River.

Along Main Street, you'll also find the full breadth of backcountry cuisine, from brew pubs to fine dining, as well as converted air streams serving signature dishes. During your time here, you'll see how the town embodies her unofficial motto, "Talkeetna, where the road ends and life begins."



## EXHILARATING EXPLORATION INCLUDED.

### /// INCLUDED EXPERIENCES

#### **Riverboat Discovery (Fairbanks)**

Cruise down the Chena River on the Riverboat Discovery sternwheeler. The family-owned boats have sailed down Fairbanks's Chena River for generations. See a bush floatplane take off beside the boat and learn about the role of these pilots in opening up the Alaskan interior. Visit an Athabascan Indian village and discover native culture. Cruise past the family home of an Iditarod champion to see how the sled dogs are trained.



#### **Gold Dredge 8 (Fairbanks)**

Travel on the narrow gauge Tanana Valley Railroad, where you'll hear tales about prospectors who flocked to this region hoping to strike it rich. Years later, between 1928 and 1959, Gold Dredge 8 played a key role in the economy of the Tanana Valley. See the mechanized operation that has been named a national engineering landmark and learn about the Trans-Alaska Pipeline's importance to domestic oil production. Gold-rush history then comes alive during a tour of the working mining camp, where you can pan for gold.



#### **Denali Natural History Tour and Tundra Wilderness Tour (Denali)**

Journey into the highly-protected backcountry of Denali National Park. You'll drive through taiga-subarctic evergreen forests, into the higher elevations that offer open views of the tundra-covered slopes and river valleys, and enjoy expansive, breathtaking views of the Alaska Range, including Denali, North America's tallest mountain. On the Denali Natural History Tour, venture 30 miles into the park, enjoying interpretive programs and award-winning presentations that showcase how the wild landscape influenced Alaska Natives and inspired early pioneers. The Tundra Wilderness Tour enables you to explore further, traveling up to 62 miles into the park, with more opportunities to see Denali and its incredible wildlife.

#### Alaska Native Heritage Center (Anchorage)

Discover the fascinating mosaic of Alaska Native cultures, traditions, and values through celebration and education at Alaska's largest cultural center. Listen to stories and learn about the states's 11 major cultural groups. Hear authentic native song and watch dance performances. The entertaining and enlightening workshops, demonstrations, and guided tours of the indoor exhibits and outdoor village sites make this one of Anchorage's most popular attractions.



#### Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center (Alyeska)

The Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center is a nonprofit wildlife refuge that is dedicated to preserving Alaska's wildlife through conservation, education, and quality animal care. The injured and orphaned animals under care are treated and rehabilitated, then released back into the wild. See black bears, wolves, caribou, elk, wood bison, moose, and many other species native to the state and learn about their habits and natural habitats.

#### Resurrection Bay Wildlife Cruise (Seward)

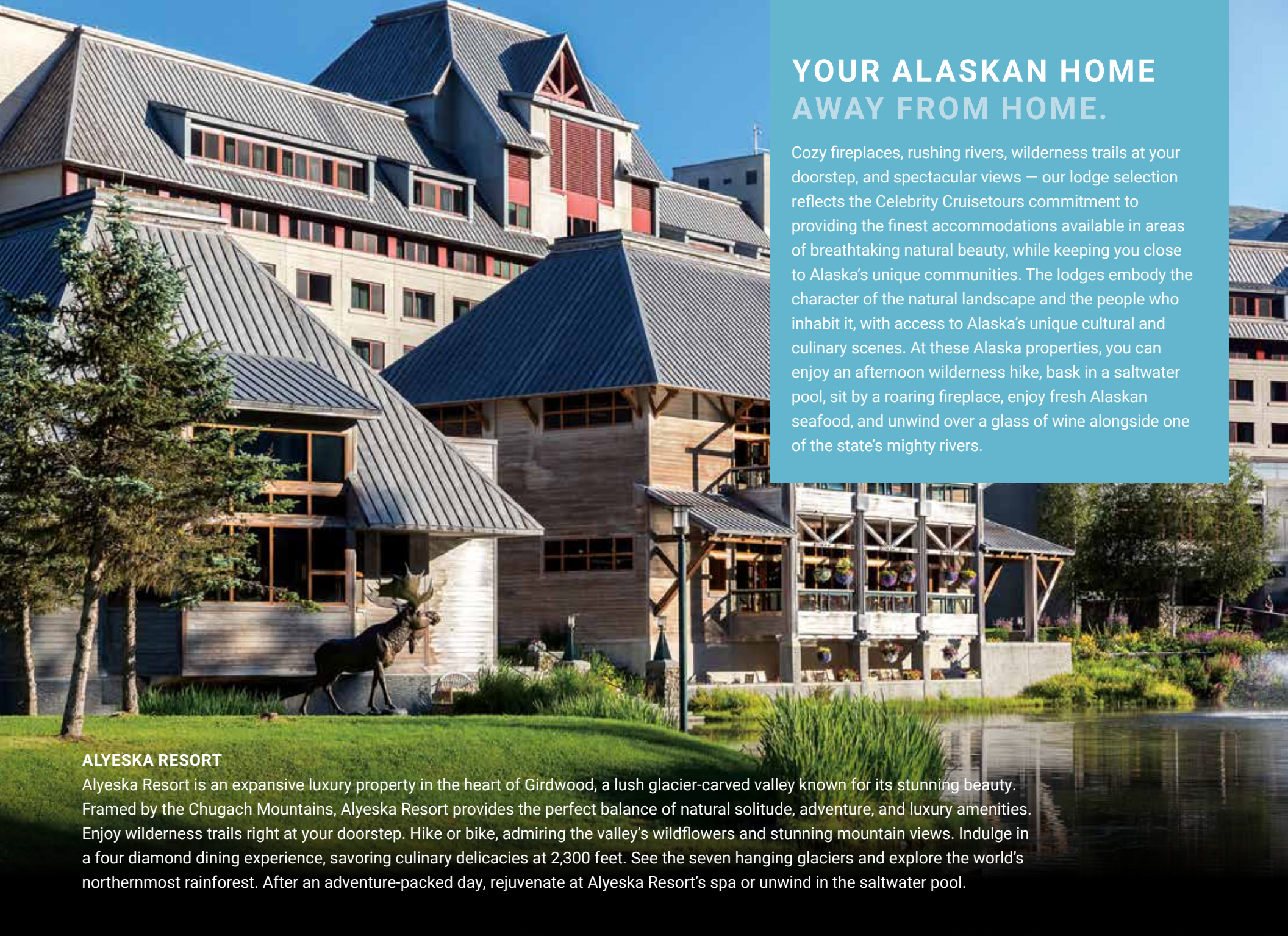
Soak in the stunning views on a coastal cruise around the Kenai Peninsula. 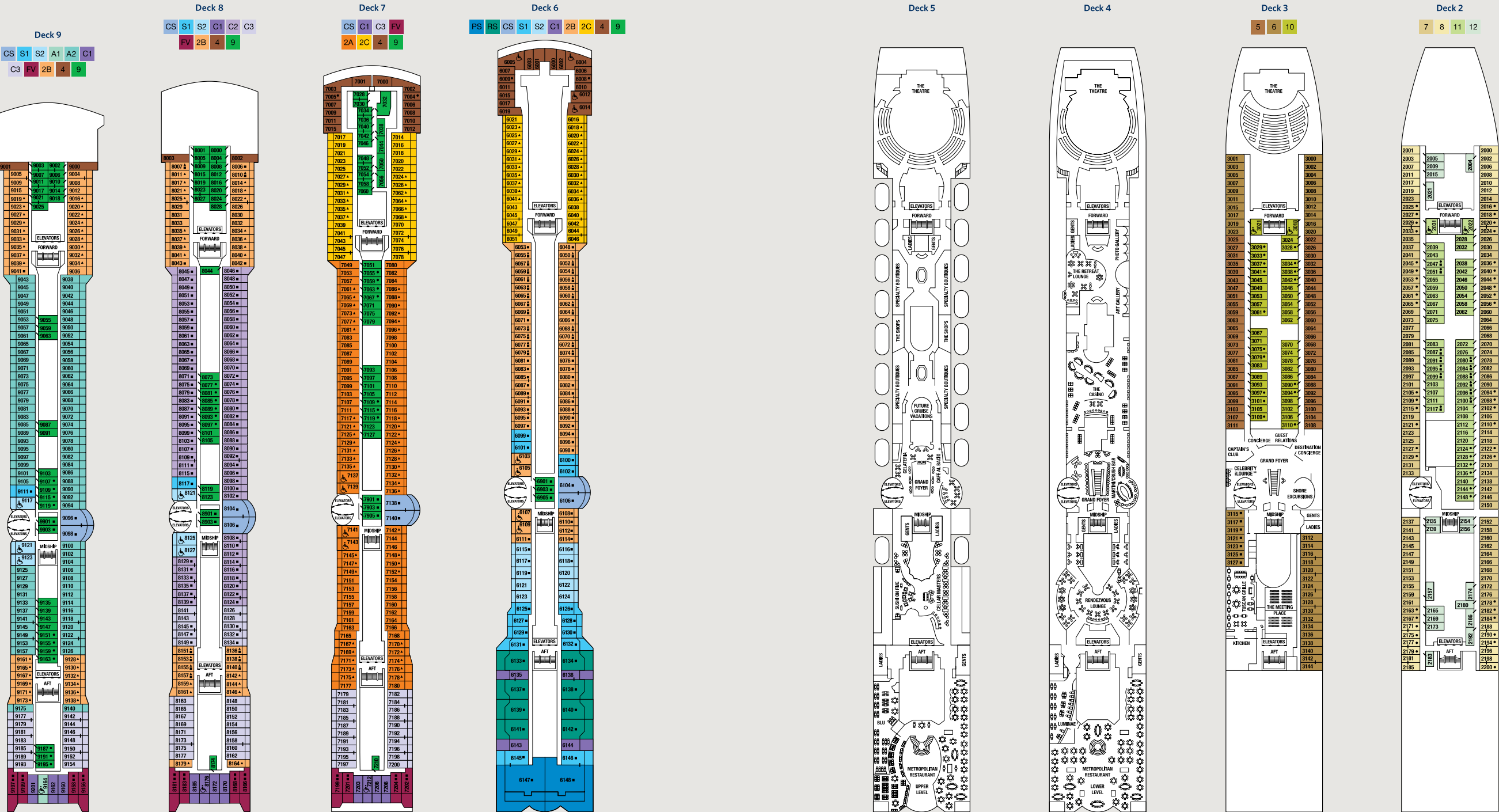

BOOKING AND PAYING FOR YOUR RESERVATION

**BOOKING A CRUISE**  
Travel agencies can provide valuable advice and services to individuals considering a cruise/Cruisetour. Celebrity encourages you to book your Celebrity cruise/Cruisetour through a travel advisor of your choice who understands your individual needs. Any travel advisor used by you in connection with making arrangements for your Celebrity cruise/Cruisetour, air accommodations, or any related travel, lodging and tours is your advisor. Celebrity is not responsible for any failure by your travel advisor to remit your deposits or payments to Celebrity, and you shall remain liable to Celebrity for any portion of the cruise or related fares that Celebrity did not receive. Similarly, Celebrity is not responsible for any failure by your travel agency to remit a refund from Celebrity to you. Celebrity's minimum age to sail unaccompanied on sailings originating in North America is 21. The minimum age to sail unaccompanied on sailings from South America, Europe, Asia, Australia and New Zealand is 18. The Company retains the right, on rare occasions, to raise the minimum age to sail unaccompanied on any sailing when local laws require or permit such a modification. This age limit will be waived for: minor children sailing with their parents or guardians in adjacent staterooms; for underage married couples; and for active duty members of the United States or Canadian military. Certain other restrictions may apply, such as proof of marriage or proof of active duty military status.

**DEPOSITS/PAYMENTS AND CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS**  
A deposit must be made in order to reserve a stateroom and receive a written confirmation.

Final payment of the balance must be received at Celebrity's offices at least 75 days (4 nights or less including Holiday sailings) and 90 days (5 nights or more including Holiday sailings) prior to sailing for sailings 5 nights or more. Galapagos sailings require final payment 120 days prior to the sailing date for Celebrity Flora<sup>SM</sup> and Celebrity Xpedition®. (The payment schedule for groups is different from that for individuals. Please consult your travel advisor for details.) If you booked your cruise through your travel agency, you may pay us directly via credit card or provide payment to your travel advisor. For express mail or courier deliveries, send to Celebrity Cruises Inc., 1050 Caribbean Way, Miami, FL 33132, Attn: Cash Processing Department. If you booked your cruise directly with Celebrity, you may pay us via credit card, money order or personal check. Celebrity accepts Visa®, MasterCard®, American Express®, Optima®, Diners Club International® and Discover® cards for individual bookings.

Cancellations must be made by you or your travel advisor. Depending on when the cruise is cancelled, a cancellation charge may apply. See chart for applicable late-cancellation charges for cruises. Consult your travel advisor for applicable late-cancellation charges for single, third and fourth guests, and holiday sailings. (Cancellation charges for groups vary from those for individuals. Please consult your travel advisor for details.)

No refunds will be made in the event of a no-show or if you interrupt your cruise. All appropriate refunds will be made directly to your credit card account (if you paid Celebrity by credit card) or through your travel advisor, if you made the reservation and paid us through a travel advisor. Celebrity is not responsible for any payments you made to your travel advisor that are not paid to Celebrity, or any refunds that Celebrity has provided to your travel advisor.

Travel advisors may impose their own charges in connection with a cruise. For example, the travel advisor may charge a flat service fee for assistance with your reservations and a value-added charge for additional amenities or services being provided by the travel advisor. In addition, travel advisors may impose their own cancellation fees. Any charges or fees of this nature are a matter strictly between the guest and their travel advisor.

To facilitate our ability to continue to provide safe and enjoyable cruises to our guests, we reserve the right to refuse to accept a booking request from an individual or group and reserve the right to cancel an existing reservation. The Refusal to Transport Policy provides, among other things, that a booking request may be denied, for example, where the guest's conduct on a prior cruise has resulted in disciplinary measures by Celebrity Cruises, Royal Caribbean International®, Azamara Club Cruises® or any other affiliated cruise line.

Celebrity is not liable for its refusal to transport any passenger or for its removal of any guest in accordance with these policies. In addition, Celebrity shall not be required to refund any amount paid by any guest who must leave the cruise vacation prematurely pursuant to either policy, nor shall Celebrity be responsible for lodging, meals, return transportation or other expenses incurred by the guest or for any consequential or punitive damages.

Any dispute between a guest and Celebrity in connection with a guest's cruise booking or cruise shall be litigated, if at all, in and before a court located in Miami, Florida, U.S.A., to the exclusion of the courts of any other state, territory, or country.

**PASSAGE TICKET CONTRACT**  
The transportation of guests and baggage on Celebrity ships is governed by the terms and conditions of the Cruise/Cruisetour Ticket Contract included as part of the cruise documentation. The Cruise/Cruisetour Ticket Contract limits your rights. **WHEELCHAIRS/ASSISTIVE DEVICES**
