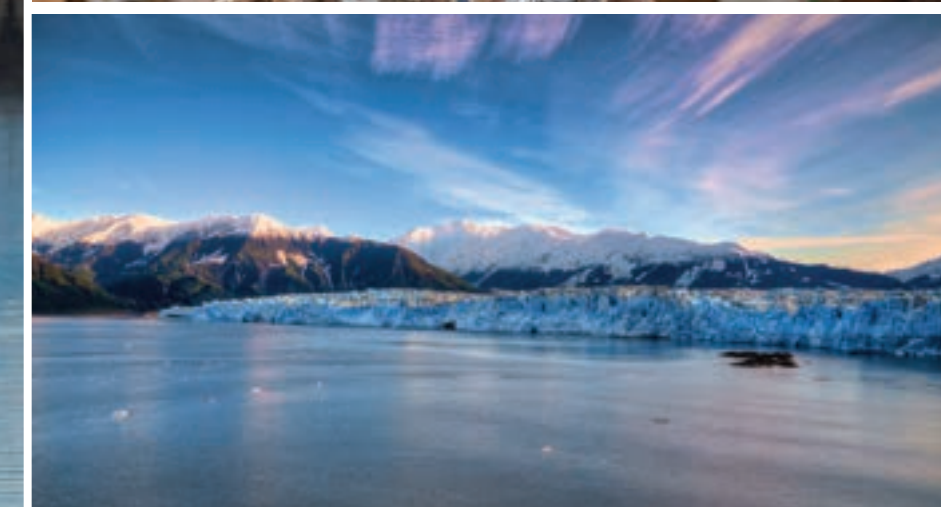

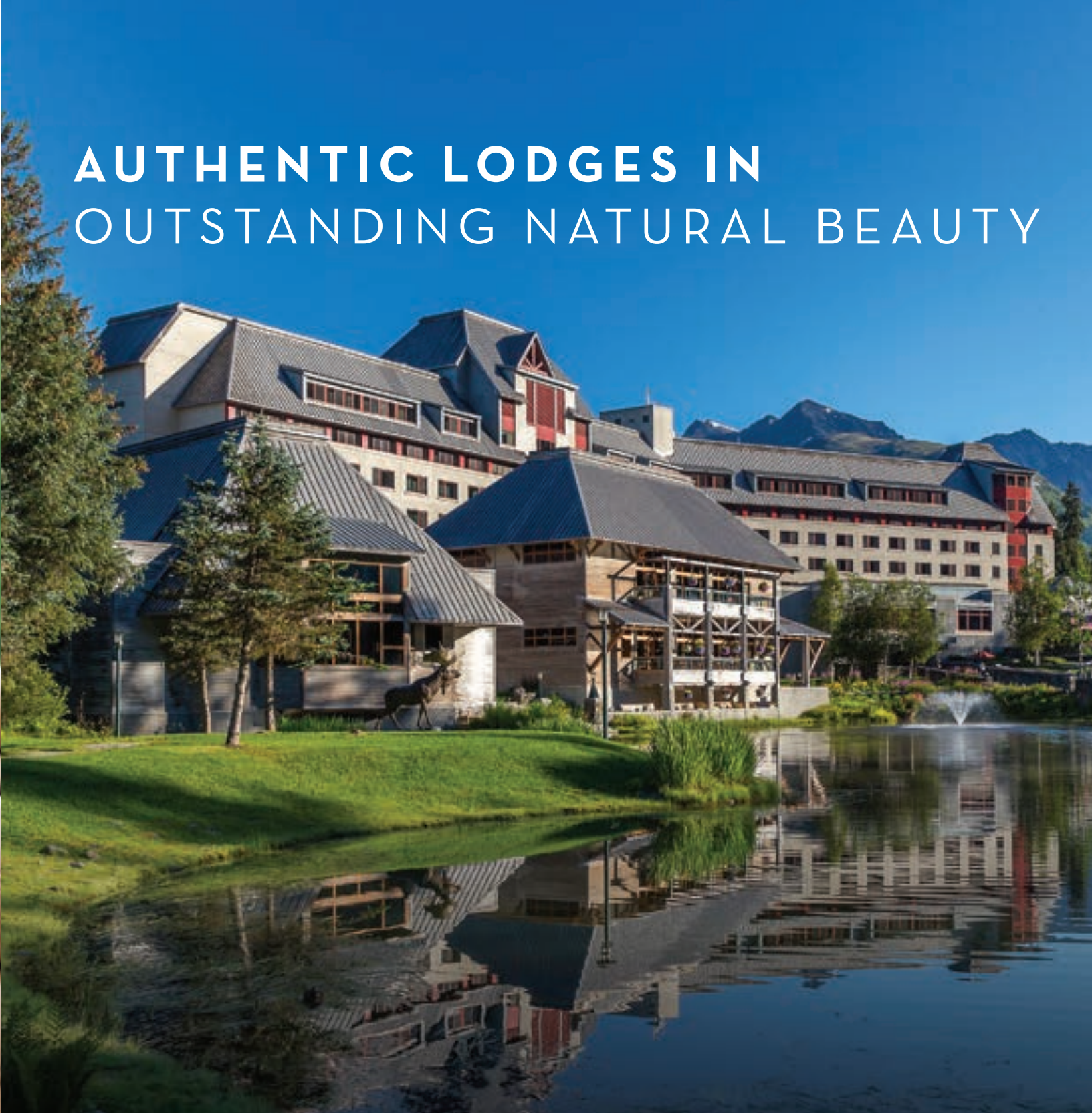




# BE SPOILED IN THE UNSPOILED WILDERNESS

# DISCOVER ALASKA'S COASTAL TOWNS

## CHART A COURSE ALONG ALASKA'S CAPTIVATING SHORELINE

### DISCOVER MASSIVE GLACIERS, IMPRESSIVE WILDLIFE, AND SCENIC VILLAGES.

Watch the vast glaciers that continue to carve this dramatic coastline. Explore scenic villages and majestic scenery home to a wide variety of wildlife. Breathe fresh mountain air and taste salmon, halibut, and king crab right from the source.

Celebrity Summit departs each Friday for seven nights northbound from Vancouver or southbound from Seward.

Along the way, you'll visit six of the most enchanting destinations in the Great Northwest: the Inside Passage, Ketchikan, Juneau, Icy Strait Point, Hubbard Glacier, Seward, and either Skagway or Sitka, depending on which direction you're sailing. Embark on the land portion of your Cruisetour either before or after your sailing.

**ICY STRAIT POINT** - Beyond the active adventures – like watching the whales, hiking the trails, and flying one of the highest and longest ZipRiders – this is a place for learning the traditions and cultures of the native Tlingit people.

**JUNEAU** - Alaska's state capital can only be reached by air or the sea. With more hiking trails than roads, Juneau welcomes you for a tram ride up the side of Mount Roberts, dog sledding on the huge Mendenhall Glacier, and whale watching in scenic Auke Bay.

**SITKA** - Nestled on Baranof Island's rugged coast, enchants with its stunning natural beauty and rich cultural heritage. Surrounded by snow-capped peaks and pristine waters, Sitka boasts lush forests and abundant wildlife. From historic sites like the Russian Cathedral to outdoor adventures in Tongass National Forest, Sitka offers a captivating blend of history and wilderness exploration.

**KETCHIKAN** - Admire the many totem poles and explore the rich vein of indigenous culture in this quintessential Alaskan town. Fly over Misty Fjords National Monument and look down on thousand-foot-tall waterfalls. Then catch a lumberjack show.

**SKAGWAY** - Return to the 1890s Klondike Gold Rush in this former boomtown, where prospectors launched their treks deep into the rugged Yukon goldfields. You can still ride the White Pass Railway here and pan for gold yourself.



# BEHOLD THE BREATHTAKING GLACIAL FORCE OF NATURE

As the largest advancing tidewater glacier in North America, Hubbard Glacier's terminal face is the dramatic end of a process that began as snowfall on the slopes of Mount Logan. Where it meets the sea, the blue wall of ice rises 350 feet above the waterline and extends 250 feet below. Forward movement of up to 36 feet per day results in regular calving — breathtaking moments when ice cleaves off the wall in enormous pieces that can reach the size of

five-story buildings. With calving occurring on a daily basis, Hubbard Glacier offers the best opportunity to observe glacial processes as they unfold — a true once-in-a-lifetime experience. Your captain will slowly turn the ship into Yakutat Bay, navigating the awe-inspiring sight of the wall of ice that stretches seven miles wide. Enjoy incredible picture-perfect views from just about anywhere as our dedicated onboard naturalist narrates the natural drama as it unfolds.

**DENALI FLYER (TALKEETNA)**  
Explore Denali, the tallest mountain in North America, and the surrounding range and wilderness on a flightseeing trip that takes you within six miles of the magnificent Kahiltna Glacier. Take in views only mountaineers and a select few get to see. Fly to the remote western end of Denali National Park and see Denali, Mt. Foraker, and Mt. Hunter, above the longest glacier in Denali National Park.



**SCENIC MOUNTAIN ASCENT AND WORLD'S LONGEST ZIPRIDER (ICY STRAIT POINT)**  
Soar 300 feet above the treetops on the world's longest ZipRider. En route to the mountainside starting point, relax on the scenic ride through the village of Hoonah, home to the indigenous Tlingit people.



**DOGGONEIT (DENALI)**  
Join an intimate group to meet the sled dogs at DogGonelt. Meet the canines, cuddle the puppies, and see the huskies' summertime training.

# DENALI



ENTER THE VAST EXPANSE OF SUBARCTIC WILDERNESS THAT IS ONE OF EARTH'S  
LAST FRONTIERS: DENALI NATIONAL PARK, HOME TO ABUNDANT WILDLIFE AND  
MAGNIFICENT VISTAS.

Denali National Park boasts six million acres of pristine wild land. The varied subarctic landscape is home to grizzly bears, moose, caribou, Dall sheep, and wolves, as well as endangered birds. Wild animals roam as they have for millennia through unspoiled backcountry of taiga forest, alpine tundra, and snow-capped peaks. The sheer expanse of wilderness, the solitude of the single road, and the park's status as one of the last true, intact, subarctic ecosystems makes Denali one of the best places in the United States to view wildlife in their natural habitat.

The Visitor Center offers fascinating natural history exhibits, films, and the opportunity to meet and speak to rangers about Denali National Park, including its centerpiece mountain, Mount McKinley. At 20,320 feet, Mount McKinley is North America's highest peak, and is still growing. Rising miles into the sky, the mountain known as

the Great One towers over the summits of the surrounding Alaska Range. The view on a clear day is a profoundly impressive sight. The highly protected backcountry that makes up the majority of the park is cleaved only by a solitary road. It runs 92 miles, stretching through evergreen forests into the higher elevations that offer open views of the tundra-covered slopes and river valleys, all framed by the indomitable Alaska Range.

And while the backcountry's pristine wilderness is protected, Denali's front country is open to a range of activities. Flightsightseeing planes soar over the mountains for breathtaking views, while rafting on the Nenana River can be a gentle float or a thrilling white-water ride. Denali National Park's unique landscape offers both active adventures and time in unspoiled nature.

# FAIRBANKS



ALASKA’S MOST REMOTE CITY IS ALSO ITS SECOND LARGEST, A GOLD-RUSH BOOMTOWN THAT TODAY IS A REGIONAL HUB FOR CULTURE AND RECREATION.

Born of a turn-of-the-century trader who found himself stranded in what is present-day downtown, Fairbanks was founded when gold was discovered nearby and the trading post blossomed into a thriving city that outlasted its gold-rush boom. Today, locals pride themselves on their independence and endurance, with many descended from Native Peoples and the gold-rush prospectors whose self-sufficiency was the driving force of the town’s conception.

Fairbanks hugs the northern bank of the Chena River that converges with the Tanana River. The sternwheelers that navigate these waters afford breathtaking views of the city and countryside, while also offering a glimpse into Alaska’s rich interior traditions.

Pan for gold in one of the many creeks that still turn up flakes of gold, or admire the native art treasures on display at the Museum of the North, whose shimmering contours reflect the mountain ranges that encircle it. With the locals playing late, including a midnight-sun baseball game held every solstice, your list of options to explore is as long as the summer nights.

# HOMER



IN THE “HALIBUT CAPITAL OF THE WORLD,” MOOSE WANDER THE STREETS AMID BOHEMIAN LOCALS, WORKING FISHERMEN, AND OUTDOOR ADVENTURERS.

Spectacular landscapes line your route all the way to the end of the road, which leads to this charming fishing village, artist colony, and hippie hangout. Feeling more like Cape Cod than a pioneer town—except for the moose that share the streets—Homer buzzes with seafood shacks, ice cream shops, art galleries, and craft centers.

Refuel with a hearty chowder or savory quiche, Check out the farmers’ market, whose vendors draw residents and visitors with freshly shucked oysters and locally brewed kombucha. As the “halibut capital of the world,” this place brims with fresh seafood.

Stroll the Spit, a natural causeway extending into Kachemak Bay, and you may spot eagles soaring overhead. Join a fishing trip or watch for whales, porpoise, and seals during the ferry ride to the town of Halibut Cove. It is surrounded by Kachemak Bay State Park, Alaska’s first state park, offering 400,000 acres of mountains, glaciers, and forests.



# ANCHORAGE



A COSMOPOLITAN CITY PERCHED ON THE EDGE OF THE WILDERNESS, ANCHORAGE IS A GATEWAY TO NATURAL ATTRACTIONS AND THE STATE’S CENTER FOR THE PRESERVATION OF ALASKAN NATIVE CULTURES.

Blending cosmopolitan excitement and the great outdoors, the city has a youthful exuberance that contributes to its lively nightlife, eclectic dining, and adventuresome atmosphere.

Beyond the city limits of “Alaska’s Big Apple,” nature commands the terrain. As many as 60 glaciers are located within an hour’s drive. Urbanites can go for a hike by day, and by night enjoy Anchorage under the late evening sun, socializing at a downtown brewery over a local craft beer. Even on weekdays it’s not uncommon to find a suited city worker angling for a catch on a lunch break.

Unlike any other American city, Anchorage boasts 250 miles of trails, sees moose passing through its neighborhoods, and is visited by whales that surface in the waters alongside the Tony Knowles Coastal

Trail. And long summers days mean more time to explore its natural beauty and sample its innovative frontier fare late into the sunlit evening.

Anchorage is home to Native Peoples from around the state, making the city the destination for discovering the history, art, and crafts at the heart of the Alaskan indigenous cultures. The Anchorage Museum preserves an extensive collection of native art, spanning prehistoric times to the present day. And the Alaskan artifacts at the Smithsonian Arctic Studies Center were curated and interpreted with help from the Alaska Native Heritage Center, a renowned cultural center and an exciting place to connect with indigenous residents.

# SEWARD



ON THE SHORES OF RESURRECTION BAY, THIS HISTORY-RICH PORT TOWN IS NESTLED AGAINST THE KENAI MOUNTAINS, AND OFFERS ACCESS TO INSPIRING LANDSCAPES, INCREDIBLE MARINE LIFE, AND EXCITING NATURAL SPECTACLES.

The pristine wilderness of the Kenai Peninsula is home to nesting seabirds, countless islands, wetlands, and breathtaking coastal views. And, as the gateway to the Kenai Fjords National Park, the Harding Icefield — an expanse of ice and snow created over 23,000 years ago — is easily within reach, and culminates in 40 glaciers that dramatically calve into the sea. Throngs of wildlife course below the surface of the glacial waters and glide above them. Pods of humpback whales are known to breach when hunting, seals and sea lions lounge on rocky outcroppings, and bald eagles soar overhead.

The rugged landscape suits Seward’s hardy locals well. Every July 4th, Seward’s runners race 1.5 miles up and down Mount Marathon. And, when not racing up mountains, you can find stalwart locals at

city watering holes and dining spots, where you can savor Alaskan seafood prepared fresh from the ocean.

Situated at a grand natural intersection where bays and fjords stretching south to the Pacific meet the crested wilderness — and connected to communities extending northwards via the famously scenic Seward Highway — Seward is emblematic of the wildly beautiful state that is Alaska.



# ALYESKA



NESTLED IN A GLACIER-CARVED VALLEY SURROUNDED BY THE GRANDEUR OF THE CHUGACH MOUNTAINS, ALYESKA OFFERS STUNNING VIEWS AT EVERY TURN.

Tucked in a luxuriant glacier-carved valley, encircled by the Chugach Mountains and bordering a temperate rainforest, Girdwood is a playground for the artists and extreme athletes who call her home. Meandering up Mt. Alyeska along the trails checkered with wildflowers to enjoy sensational views, is as pure a Girdwood experience as a helicopter ride to an alpine camp, where Alaskan sled dogs are waiting to be driven.

The luxurious Hotel Alyeska is the attraction of the area, offering a perfect blend of service and hospitality while keeping you connected to the beauty of your surroundings.

Journey to the top of the mountain on the Aerial Tram. From the 2,300-foot summit, the view of the seven hanging glaciers is awe-inspiring. In addition to enjoying the wild outdoors, indulge in the extravagant indoors, with both casual and elegant dining perched on the mountain top, or relax at the spa in its lush valley setting.

# TALKEETNA



SITUATED ON THREE RIVERS IN SIGHT OF THE GREAT MOUNTAIN, TALKEETNA OFFERS BREATHTAKING VIEWS, A FOLKSY FRONTIER SPIRIT AND ENDLESS OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES.

With a population of under 1,000, Talkeetna has a small but lively local community dedicated to keeping the backcountry spirit of Alaska alive. The log cabin cafés, along with the heritage buildings of its historic Main Street, provide a place where you can mill with the bohemians, aviators, and adventurers who call the town home.

The town’s unique location offers breathtaking views of the tallest peak in North America and provides access to every imaginable way to experience the magnificence of “The Great One” – from seasoned bush pilots taking you up into the skies and over the awe-inspiring north face, to leisurely hikes on quiet trails and river rafting down the glacier-fed Talkeetna River.

Along Main Street, you’ll also find the full breadth of backcountry cuisine, from brew pubs to fine dining, as well as converted air streams serving signature dishes. During your time here, you’ll see how the town embodies her unofficial motto, “Talkeetna, where the road ends and life begins.”



# EXHILARATING EXPERIENCES ARE PART OF THE JOURNEY

A Celebrity Cruisetour offers the ideal balance of included experiences and free time to explore on your own. On every Cruisetour, you'll take a narrated wilderness journey into the heart of Denali National Park. On select Cruisetours, you'll enjoy included experiences that showcase the special qualities of each destination. These adventures are among the highlights.



**RIVERBOAT DISCOVERY (FAIRBANKS)**  
Cruise down the Chena River on the Riverboat Discovery sternwheeler. The family-owned boats have sailed down Fairbanks' Chena River for generations. See a bush floatplane take off beside the boat and learn about the role of these pilots in opening up the Alaskan interior. Visit an Athabascan Indian village and discover native culture. Cruise past the family home of an Iditarod champion to see how the sled dogs are trained.



**GOLD DREDGE 8 (FAIRBANKS)**  
Travel on the narrow gauge Tanana Valley Railroad, where you'll hear tales about prospectors who first flocked to this region hoping to strike it rich. Years later, between 1928 and 1959, Gold Dredge 8 played a key role in the economy of the Tanana Valley. See the mechanized operation that has been named a national engineering landmark and learn about the Trans-Alaska Pipeline's importance to domestic oil production. Gold-rush history then comes alive during a tour of the working mining camp, where you can pan for gold.



**DENALI NATURAL HISTORY TOUR AND TUNDRA WILDERNESS TOUR (DENALI)**  
Journey into the highly-protected backcountry of Denali National Park. You'll drive through taiga-subarctic evergreen forests, into the higher elevations that offer open views of the tundra-covered slopes and river valleys, and enjoy expansive, breathtaking views of the Alaska Range, including Mount McKinley, North America's tallest mountain.



INCLUDED EXPERIENCES



ALASKA NATIVE HERITAGE CENTER (ANCHORAGE)

Discover the fascinating mosaic of Alaska Native cultures, traditions, and values through celebration and education at Alaska’s largest cultural center. Listen to stories and learn about the state’s 11 major cultural groups. Hear authentic native song and watch dance performances. The entertaining and enlightening workshops, demonstrations, and guided tours of the indoor exhibits and outdoor village sites make this one of Anchorage’s most popular destinations.



**ALASKA WILDLIFE CONSERVATION CENTER (ALYESKA)**  
The Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center is a nonprofit wildlife refuge that is dedicated to preserving Alaska’s wildlife through conservation, education, and quality animal care. The injured and orphaned animals under care are treated and rehabilitated, then released back into the wild. See black bears, wolves, caribou, elk, wood bison, moose, and many other species native to the state and learn about their natural habitats.

**RESURRECTION BAY WILDLIFE CRUISE (SEWARD)**  
Soak in the stunning views on a coastal cruise around the Kenai Peninsula. Hear about the fascinating history of Resurrection Bay while viewing the jagged cliffs, seabirds, marine wildlife, and alpine glaciers, including the magnificent Bear Glacier. The narrated 4-hour journey takes you past forest, coves, and waters that form the natural habitat of species like orcas, sea otters, and bald eagles. You’ll travel to Fox Island, a remote and mountainous island nestled in Resurrection Bay, to savor a delicious buffet-style lunch of wild Alaska salmon and prime rib.

**ALASKA SEALIFE CENTER (SEWARD)**  
Get up close and personal with puffins, octopuses, and sea lions, while learning about Alaska’s diverse marine life and ecosystem at the state’s only public aquarium and ocean wildlife rescue center. The Alaska SeaLife Center contributes to the scientific understanding of marine mammals, birds, and fish in the arctic and subarctic through research, animal care, and other work by staff specialists.

**ALYESKA RESORT**
